## **SUMMARY**

A CIT will represent Burnett County 4-H in a positive manner and he/she will work with the Summer Camp Director and camp counselors to help provide a safe, positive, fun and challenging learning experience for all campers.

## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Assist counselors with taking care of and supporting campers.
- Get to know each camper in assigned group.
- Be a positive role model for campers (behavior, dress, and language).
- Assist counselors with instruction of campers.
- Work as a team member with the entire camp staff, and participate in all camper activities.
- Ensure that teamwork and good sportsmanship are emphasized in all activities.
- Assist counselors with preparing activities for each camp session.
- Help maintain a clean, safe cabin and campsite.
- Assist counselors with the evening camp programs, such as dances, skits, campfires, night hikes and evening snacks.
- Attend a CIT training session.
- Assist with light maintenance in the entire camp facility immediately before and after camp.
- Fulfill any other duties deemed necessary by the Summer Camp Director.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Must be at least 12 years of age as of January 1.
- Demonstrated maturity and responsibility.
- Positive attitude, enthusiastic, and willingness to work as the member of a team.
- Desire to learn about and gain experience in camp counseling.
- Eager to accept new responsibilities and follow through.
- First Aid and CPR certification helpful, but not necessary.
