SESSION DESCRIPTIONS

Salt Watercolor Painting

Alexis Slater, Burnett County 4-H Junior Leader

Learn a new painting technique and create art you can enter in the county fairs. This session involves learning about a water color technique using salt, liquid water color with eye droppers. Please wear a shirt that you can paint in. This session will be offered up to two times. Maximum number of participants is 12 per session.



Picture Cube for Mother's Day

Participants will Modge Podge six photos onto a wooden cube for the Mom in their life. Participants will learn to select then cut photos to size and how to Modge Podge photos onto a wooden cube to create a gift for Mother's Day. This session can be offered up to two times. Maximum of 9 participants total. Participants will receive an email confirming they are registered to attend this session. Participants are required to bring six photos they want to use on their cube. **Important:** If no photos-participants won't be able to make this craft.



Mini-Luminaries

Blended crayon shavings in waxed paper are ironed and fastened to popsicle stick frames. A flameless LED votive is placed inside creating a pleasing accent. Participants will learn an enjoyable way to use color in a craft project. Creating a craft that is useful. This session can be offered up to two times. Maximum number of participants is 8 per session.



Storybook Skits

Participants will choose and listen to a story. Then they will use their creativity to act out the story. Participants will learn about using their imaginations, characters, and plot development. Participants are asked to bring their good attitude and creative mind-set! This session can be offered up to three times. Maximum number of participants is 8 per session.



PAWsome Dog Toys

Participants will learn how to make easy dog toys. They will make multiple toys and be asked to donate at least one toy to the Burnett County Humane Society. Participants will learn how to make dog toys and how to serve their community. **Important:** Participants are asked to bring old t-shirts to cut up and fleece and other fabric scraps. It will be PAWsome! This session can be offered up to three times. Maximum number of participants is 10 per session.



Marbled Paper

April Close, Wood Creek Parent

Participants will learn how to make marbled paper using shaving cream and food coloring. Participants will learn how to combine the two items to make unique designs on paper. Paper can, once dried, be used for scrapbooking paper or to make a greeting card. This session can be offered up to three times. Maximum number of participants is 10 per session.
